Tuesday 16 <sup>th</sup> June after school	RSE meeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>an opportunity to talk to staff about the Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) curriculum before we teach it</li></ul>
Monday 22 <sup>nd</sup> June 8am	Class photo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>arrive at school at 8am</b> ready to have the class photo taken at 8:05am before we go swimming</li></ul>
Monday 22 <sup>nd</sup> June to Friday 26 <sup>th</sup> June	Year 6 swimming lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>need a towel, swimming costume or trunks and a swimming hat</b></li><li><b>need a water bottle and, ideally, a snack</b></li><li>need to be at school at <b>8am on Monday and 8:05am on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday</b></li></ul>
Wednesday 1 <sup>st</sup> July	Nurse transition meeting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>an NHS nurse will talk to each class about how your child can get support with their transition to secondary school</li></ul>
Wednesday 1 <sup>st</sup> July	KS2 picnic and sports afternoon at Southchurch Park	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>join your child at around 11:45 the Southchurch Park</b></li><li><b>need a packed</b> (free school meals provided) <b>and a water bottle</b></li><li>need a <b>sunhat and suncream</b>, or a raincoat (depending on the weather)</li><li>need a <b>PE kit and trainers</b></li><li>you can take your child home from the park</li></ul>
Thursday 2 <sup>nd</sup> July	Open afternoon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>end of school to 5:15pm</b></li><li>school will be open for you to view your child's books and work</li></ul>
Friday 3 <sup>rd</sup> July	Transition Day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>most schools invite your child to visit their secondary school on this day</li><li>if your child's day is on a different day, they come to school as usual</li><li>each secondary school has different arrangements so they will contact you direct. Any questions, please ask them</li></ul>
week beginning Monday 6 <sup>th</sup> July	Bikeability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>cycling lessons at school (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday. Maybe Thursday and Friday too)</b></li><li>if you said your child was bringing a bike and helmet, please make sure they bring them to school every day</li><li>water bottle and suncream, ideally a snack too</li><li>raincoat if needed</li><li>trainers</li></ul>
Tuesday 14 <sup>th</sup> July	Disco	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>£2</li><li>straight after school</li><li>children can buy snacks and drinks</li></ul>



Wednesday 15 <sup>th</sup> July	End of year production	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>gates open at 2:00pm</b></li> <li>• <b>production starts at 2:10pm</b> in the South Hall</li> <li>• parents, carers and family are welcome</li> <li>• <b>if you are planning to bring more than 4 people, please let Miss Hammond or Mrs McCarthy know (a note is fine)</b></li> <li>• children can go home with their parents afterwards</li> </ul>
Thursday 16 <sup>th</sup> July	BBQ lunch during school day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• BBQ for lunch</li> <li>• <b>book on ParentPay at home or at school</b> and choose BBQ option (menu to be confirmed nearer the time)</li> <li>• usual price for lunch or covered by free school meals</li> <li>• bring packed lunch if do not want the BBQ</li> <li>• water fight! Children can bring squirters etc (on this day only!)</li> </ul>
